Hollywood Basic Local Negotiations Update: Local 44, 884 Reach Tentative Agreement with AMPTP Basic General Negotiations to Resume

This week marked the conclusion of negotiations between each of the 13 individual West Coast Studio Locals of the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE) and the Alliance of Motion Picture and Television Producers (AMPTP). Affiliated Property Craftspersons Local 44 reached a tentative agreement with the employers on April 25 while Studio Teachers, IATSE Local 884, reached a tentative agreement with the employers on April 19.







MPTF's Veterans Benefits Assistance Program

Did You Know?

- MPTF's Veterans Benefits Assistance program assists entertainment industry military veterans, surviving spouses, and industry members' parents who served in the military in securing disability, Aid & Attendance, and caregiver stipend benefits.
- Program staff walk clients through the claims process from beginning to end and act as liaisons with the Veterans Administration, thus eliminating confusing and frustrating paperwork burden and minimizing the need for clients to interact with the VA directly.
- A member does not have to be a combat veteran in order to qualify for benefits. In fact, MPTF has secured significant amounts of benefit funds for peacetime veterans and veterans who served during wartime but in non-combat roles.
- The program has secured over \$268K in retroactive monies for L728 members since they began tracking outcomes in 2015. This figure represents almost 30% of all retroactive monies secured on behalf of IA members.




The Local 728 Food Pantry


