



#### **MPTF's Veterans Benefits Assistance Program**

Did You Know?

- MPTF's Veterans Benefits Assistance program assists entertainment industry military veterans, surviving spouses, and industry members' parents who served in the military in securing disability, Aid & Attendance, and caregiver stipend benefits.
- Program staff walk clients through the claims process from beginning to end and act as liaisons with the Veterans Administration, thus eliminating confusing and frustrating paperwork burden and minimizing the need for clients to interact with the VA directly.
- A member does not have to be a combat veteran in order to qualify for benefits. In fact, MPTF has secured significant amounts of benefit funds for peacetime veterans and veterans who served during wartime but in non-combat roles.
- The program has secured over \$268K in retroactive monies for L728 members since they began tracking outcomes in 2015. This figure represents almost 30% of all retroactive monies secured on behalf of IA members.





#### Information regarding the passing of Local 80 member Rico Priem

We received this information from Local 80 and they requested our help combating the disinformation regarding the accident that led to Rico's death. The rumors are disrespectful, full of assumptions, and hurtful to the family and friends of Rico. Please find attached a letter from Rico's sister Karen addressing what is known about the accident.

May 15, 2024,

To Rico's extended family and the Local 80,

In the early morning hours on May 11, 2024, my heart shattered to pieces. My brother, Ric, AKA RICO, was pronounced deceased in a single vehicle roll over collision and was pronounced dead at the scene. To me, this news was surreal. I just saw him on May 4<sup>th</sup>, and we were laughing and talking about his retirement. I was so looking forward to seeing more of him and hanging out! As many of you know, Rico was not only a loving, caring and funny man, he was also the most loving, caring, silly and protective brother, my sister Meg and I could have wanted.

Over the years, at family gatherings, Rico would make us laugh, and tease my sister and me, as well as our children. Rico was a great uncle to my sons, Michael, and Timothy and to my sister's daughter, Michele. As life went on, Rico would continue to tell us stories of being a Grip in Hollywood and all the people he worked with and for. He never had a bad thing to say, he loved his job and especially the people he worked with, work was his happy place!!

As news spread of Rico's death, the media, in its usual fashion, started posting false narratives. I will address this issue, to clarify the reference that alcohol was involved. On May 13, 2024, Rico's brother-in-law, Bill, also retired Law Enforcement, spoke to the CHP Officer handling the investigation. During the conversation, the CHP Officer told Bill, although there was UNOPENED alcohol found in the vehicle, the CHP Officer would have to investigate that possibility as well. Which in that line of work, he is correct. However, the CHP Officer also told Bill, the path Rico's car took in the course of the collision and where it came to rest, that it was most likely a medical emergency.

On May 15, 2024, I emailed the CHP Officer. The following is an excerpt from that email: "As you know I did 24 years in Law Enforcement to include my last 8 years as the Family Protection Sergent of Investigations. I understand completely not ruling that out, however when it comes to the media, the more appropriate response would have been - "At this point in the investigation, it is undetermined." If a reporter asked follow up questions, as they always do in hopes of fueling a false narrative, the response could have been, "there was UNOPENED alcohol, however it is too early to say in this investigation!"

I know my brother had a medical emergency, which caused his demise. The truth will come out in the end, as an Investigation and Autopsy are in progress.

As days went by and I saw more and more news about Rico's death, an initial Instagram post by Nina Moskol, started an avalanche of support for Rico. As I read, heard, and saw the enormous amount of love, comradery and brother and sisterhood, I was amazed and understood why Rico loved you, his profession and called you family!!!

My family and I can't even begin to thank each one of you for wrapping RICO in your arms, loving him, and showing the world who he really was! While my heart is still in a million pieces, you have restored a piece of my heart.

Thank you, with all my broken pieces of heart! I have immense respect for you and what you do! Stay safe and God Bless You!
