Cast & Crew Advises EDD Will Reject Loan Out Corporations

The IATSE was informed that Cast & Crew received notification from Employment Development Department (EDD) of their refusal to recognize the use of loan out corporations. The notification was part of an EDD audit of Cast & Crew. This determination by the EDD may possibly affect all loan outs in the entire entertainment industry.

If you worked as a loan out in 2021 through Cast & Crew, you may be receiving a notice of the EDD's intention to assess unemployment insurance and other employment taxes on the compensation. The notice will also explain how to appeal the proposed amounts.

If you receive this notice, you must file your appeal in response to the EDD within 30 days of the notice to timely appeal the EDD determination.

The California IATSE Council (CIC) is looking into this issue and what this means for the members of the IATSE. Unfortunately, we do not have the full details but will continue to update members with new information.






A 32- year member of Local 728, Brother MacDonald passed away on May 26, 2024.


