From the desk of the Treasurer-Call Steward...Dues and Assessments

Members who are behind in paying their dues will not be assessed for working while delinquent under certain conditions.

To qualify, they must report to the Call Steward that they are going to work or have begun employment by noon of their first day of employment. This is particularly true if that member signed a promissory note and accepted a strike fund loan in which case they were required to place their name on the books.

Members are expected to make a minimum payment of at least 1/2 of the amount due on their oldest outstanding quarter after they are paid for the job they worked, unless that job was for 16 hours worked hours or less in that work week.

Members who accept employment while delinquent without informing the Call Steward may be assessed a \$50.00 charge.

Any member who has accepted a Strike Fund loan and has been found to have subsequently failed to inform the Call Steward of having been employed and thus abrogated their promissory note agreement, may have their loan repayment schedule adjusted to begin 90 days from the date of employment or September 8th 2024, whichever is sooner.
