Those who knew Spike were blessed by his passion for everything and everyone around him. A US Army Veteran, Spike represented the ideals of service to his friends, co-workers, and community. Those who didn't know Spike are touched by his commitment to making things better in our industry as he constantly promoted safety in our workplaces and was never shy about speaking up for the needs and rights of those around him.

Local 728 is keenly aware that we are not alone in our grief. Many of our sister IATSE Locals have experienced tragedies similar to ours and unfortunately, many of our sister Locals will experience these tragedies in the future.

As we honor the people who went to work and never came home this Worker's Memorial Day, Local 728 asks that you not only remember our Brother Spike Osorio but also the members we have lost on the job from other IATSE Locals, including Local 33, Local 44, Local 80, Local 600, Local 729, and our sister unions SAG/AFTRA, DGA, and Teamsters. If you don't know who passed while at work from any of these locals, please ask a member so we can remember them all.

We are all part of the IATSE family, and no job or task is worth losing a family member. Everyone should come home better off than when they went to work. Be safe and stay strong.


