Contract Voting Notification

As we head back into bargaining next week with the goal of concluding contract negotiations for the Hollywood Basic Agreement, I wanted to alert all of you to a potential timeline for an electronic ratification vote should we be successful in bargaining an agreement worthy of presenting to you for your ratification. As a reminder, you need to be in good standing in order to vote.

The current timeline is as follows IF and only IF we have a tentative agreement by June 28:

✓ June 29 Hybrid TownHall to review deal points ahead of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) drafting (To attend the tentative 6/29 Negotiations Town Hall, please see the upcoming events section further down)

- ✓ July 8 Voting Test email sent to all members
- ✓ July 10 Corrections on email addresses due
- ✓ July 13 Inter-Local TownHall in Webinar format for MOA review
- ✓ July 14 Ballots go out via email
- ✓ July 18 Ratification Vote results announced





Union Resources

Entertainment Community Fund-Palm View Apartments

If you are on disability and need housing, Palm View Apartments may be for you. Located in West Hollywood, the complex is affordable housing owned by the Entertainment Community Fund specifically for entertainment professionals who are disabled. You must be receiving Social Security Disability (or a union pension) to qualify. They have both 1 and 2-bedroom units, and both wait lists are currently open. All 1-bedroom units are part of a project-based Section 8 voucher program, so the rents are very affordable (typically around 30% of one's income).
