

Motion regarding S&T Director position as passed by the Membership on 9/17/16

That the term of the Safety and Training Director be defined as a repeating three-year cycle beginning on February 1, 2014. There shall be no limit to the number of terms a member can be appointed to the position of Safety and Training Director of Local 728.

That a review of the Safety and Training Director's performance be established as follows: no later than the November General Membership Meeting of the third year of the term of the Safety and Training Director, the Safety and Training Committee shall evaluate the Safety and Training Director's performance through surveys of members who attend training program classes, vendors who work with the safety and training program, and representatives of CSATTF; a review of training materials; and an interview with the Safety and Training Director.

That it shall be announced at the September Membership Meeting that applications for the position of Safety and Training Director shall be available (online and at the Local) and can be accepted between the November Membership meeting and the December Executive Board meeting of the third year of the Safety and Training Director's term. The recipient (s) of the applications shall be determined by the Executive Board. The Safety and Training Committee shall review and present all applications received, and with the results of the evaluation of the current Safety and Training Director, make **3** recommendations to the Executive Board at the January Executive Board Meeting.

That applicants for the position of Safety and Training Director are required to be members in good standing.

That if the Executive Board determines that a new Safety and Training Director is to be placed, the outgoing Safety Training Director shall be retained for thirty (30) business days, and continue to receive the same compensation and benefits while retained, to provide adequate transfer of responsibility. At the discretion of the Executive Board, the thirty (30) business day period may be extended up to an additional thirty (30) business days, if so needed.

That the compensation for the Safety and Training Director be defined as a 60 hour weekly CLT (occ. code of 5401) rate as stipulated in the Hollywood Basic Agreement. The Safety and Training Director shall be allowed to independently negotiate additional compensation with the Contract Services Administration Training Trust Fund for classes presented.
