Hello 728 Member,

The IATSE Local 728 Scholarship Fund was established to help students of 728 members pay for continuing education after high school, including college, trade school or vocational training.

The Scholarship Fund, in consultation with the Scholarship Committee, has determined the scholarship should be a guaranteed benefit of Local 728 membership. To realize this goal, we've made some changes that will streamline the application process and make the awarding of scholarships more equitable and accessible for future generations.

- Starting this year, all scholarship recipients will receive identical awards determined by the following formula:

$$\boxed{\text{Total Scholarship Fund Amount}} \div \boxed{\text{Total Number Of Applicants}} = \boxed{\text{\$\$\$ Amount Per Applicant}}$$

- Yearly awards will vary depending on the amount of money in the fund and the number of applicants, but will always be at least \$728 and at most \$5000.
- There are no academic requirements and no interviews.
- Scholarships must be used within 24 months of being awarded and may be applied to any year of undergraduate college, vocational training or trade school.
- All dependents of a living or deceased Local 728 member in good standing are eligible to apply.

We wish your loved ones good luck and are happy to help them build a brighter future.

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2023 I.A.T.S.E. Local 728 Scholarship Application Instructions

To receive the 728 Scholarship, you must:

- Be the legal dependent of a Local 728 active or retired member in good standing or be the legal dependent of a deceased Local 728 member who was in good standing at the time of death.
- Be younger than age 26.
- Be a full time student at a community college, four year college, trade school or vocational school. Full time status will be as defined by the institution you are attending.
- Make application no sooner than the academic year of graduation from high school or attainment of G.E.D. and no later than the academic year of graduation from college, trade school or vocational school.
- Use the scholarship within twenty-four (24) months of the award date and during any semester of school prior to graduation.

The procedure for making an application is as follows:

- Request an application form from the Local 728 office or download the application form from www.iatse728.org.
- Complete the application and attach a recent photo of yourself for publication in The Bulletin, the newsletter of Local 728.
- Mail or deliver completed application package to the Local 728 office prior to the application deadline:

- Recipients will be notified of their awards in May 2023. All scholarship awards will be paid directly to the school, not to the student.
