<u>Understand Terms of the New Contract – Triple Time Edition</u> (RESEND)

This blurb was sent out last September without the following context from the Basic Agreement, Paragraph 11 (a) (3) "Golden Hour Provisions":

"For "on production" employees only who are employed on television productions..., Golden Hours...shall be based on hours worked, rather than elapsed."

We now have TRIPLE TIME (3x) for all hours worked after 15 hours consecutive or elapsed so this would be inclusive of lunch (except where better conditions exist). You do a half hour lunch, it's after 14.5 hours and an hour lunch, triple time starts at 14. Additionally, triple time would be paid at 4.5x on a sixth day and 6x on a seventh day.

What does this mean?

Triple time shall be paid after 15 elapsed hours worked for the first 5 days in a workweek. Four and a half time shall be paid after 15 elapsed hours worked on the sixth day of the workweek. Six time shall be paid after 15 elapsed hours worked on the seventh day in a workweek.

Put together with the rest invasion improvements of a minimum 30 minutes at triple time, we now have Triple Time K-Rails around the day to secure rest on long days.






Love and Solidarity Film Screening



The deadline to sign-up for the drawing is Monday, May 5th.






Brother Steven E. Pellant
