New California Film & Television Jobs Program Materials

Following up on last week's announcement of the Film Incentive news, please see links below related to the implementation of the new California Film & Television Jobs Program. These materials are intended to help you better understand the key elements of the program and the California Film Commission's (CFC) timetable for announcing and accepting applications for the first year of funding (July 2025–July 2026).

Many of the changes in the program can be implemented immediately, as they involve adjustments to existing numbers rather than changes to the statute itself. However, the inclusion of animation (TV and feature films) and large-scale competition game shows represents a significant expansion of the program. Because these are new categories, the CFC must go through a full regulationwriting and public comment process. Funding for these genres will become available in January 2026, and the CFC is already setting aside funds to support them. These genres will not have separate funding buckets but will be included within the overall allocations for television and feature films.

This week, the Entertainment Union Coalition (EUC) is expected to release a letter through Action Network, encouraging all 165,000 members to send thankyou messages to lawmakers in Sacramento. If we see the same strong participation as in our previous two letter-writing campaigns, it will make a powerful impact. Watch out for it!
