Artists & Creators Must Have Transparency NOW!

"The AI Copyright Transparency Act" - AB412

Local 800 recently sent an email blast to their members encouraging them to sign this petition supporting California Bill AB412, and I would encourage you to do the same.

Sign the Petition Here

- In short, what this bill does: requires AI companies to be transparent about what copyrighted material is in their training datasets.
- In the L800 AI Committee, when speaking to field experts on AI and labor, the #1 thing they recommend in regard to protecting workers in the age of AI is transparency in the datasets. An AI regulatory opportunity like this bill is not going to present itself again.
- The bill has been endorsed by the California IATSE Council, Entertainment Union Coalition, CA Labor Federation, and a giant list of other labor organizations. Co-Sponsoring organizations include SAG-AFTRA, National Assoc of Voice Actors, and the Authors Guild.
- Signing the petition takes 1 minute.


