In The Spotlight this week!

\$256 Million for 22 Production Allocations Announced

On Thursday, August 27th, the California Film Commission announced that 22 television productions have been chosen to receive \$256 million of California's Film and Television Incentive. These projects, chosen from a record-breaking 400% increase in submissions, will result in good union jobs for IATSE members

and our fellow entertainment union kin. This is due to YOUR support. Your letters, calls, and social media posts put the pressure on our state legislators to push the California Film and Television Jobs Program over the finish line, resulting in an expansion of the state's incentive and modernizing of the program.

Of the CFC TV series productions selected, there are 22 TV projects, creating 6,500 cast and crew jobs with \$1.1 billion generated into the CA economy. Thursday's announcement is double the number of productions, double the jobs (3,583) and double the revenue (\$509 million) of those announced in December 2024. This week the CFC was accepting feature film applications—this would be the first under the 4.0 program. We will know about those selections in early October.

As a thank you to our elected officials for their support of the modernized and better funded California Film and Television Jobs program, the Entertainment Union Coalition (EUC) hand-delivered Keep California Rolling popcorn buckets last week. Included in the popcorn bucket is a QR to watch a thank you video from EUC members, which you can view here.

To thank lawmakers for standing arm-in-arm with us, California members are encouraged to submit a letter of thanks to our representatives in Sacramento. Let's keep the momentum and Keep California Rolling!


