Loeb traveled to Washington D.C. on February 11th to meet with legislators and administration officials about implementing a federal film and television production tax incentive to return and maintain U.S. film and television jobs. On behalf of the IATSE membership, he urged federal policymakers to level the playing field for American workers and make the U.S. film and television industry more competitive on the global stage.



Important Alert Regarding EP Payroll Checks

Important notice: Entertainment Partners payroll checks will look different starting April 6.

Beginning April 6, 2026, payroll checks from Entertainment Partners will arrive in envelopes that look different than what you're accustomed. These changes are part of ongoing security enhancements designed to protect your pay from mail theft.

What's changing:


- EP payroll envelopes will no longer have a company logo or familiar return address
- The return address will be a PO Box
- The envelope window will be smaller to make it harder to see that it contains a check

Payroll timing and processing remain the same.

Because the envelope may look unfamiliar, after April 6 please be careful to ensure that you do not discard envelopes that may contain payroll checks.


