In The Spotlight this week!

2027 Basic Negotiations Update

With the Guilds in the middle of negotiations and ratification, I wanted you to have an idea of where we are, how it affects us, and what the Local is doing about it.

Writers Guild of America (WGA) members are currently voting on their tentative agreement with the Alliance of Motion Picture & Television Producers (AMPTP) on April 4, 2026. It includes:

- wage increases
- a four-year term
- major changes to the funding and structure of their health plan

The results of the WGA ratification vote will be available after April 24.

SAG-AFTRA resumes their negotiations with the AMPTP on April 27, followed by the DGA scheduled to begin on May 11.

The entertainment industry has long been subject to “pattern bargaining.” This is when the results of one negotiation affect the others, especially around wage increases and the length of the agreement.

The Hollywood Reporter reported that the steep decline in the WGA's health plan reserves "affected the union's leverage" at the negotiating table, leading to agreement on a longer term based on the AMPTP funding their health plans.

We will see what the SAG-AFTRA and the DGA agree to in the coming weeks and how the pattern shapes up.

In the meantime, Local 728 is preparing for 2027 negotiations with our Negotiations Committee holding its first meeting last month.

Comprehensive OSHA training tailored to film and television leaders who want to strengthen compliance, prevent hazards, and keep their crews safe.

The OSHA 30 is the advanced level of OSHA Outreach Training, created for department heads, supervisors, safety coordinators, and other leaders seeking to deepen their knowledge of compliance and workplace safety. With a focus on the motion picture and television industry, this course equips participants with the tools to recognize hazards, apply prevention strategies, and foster a culture of safety across sets, shops, and on-location shoots. Using industry-specific examples, it provides a strong foundation in OSHA regulations while addressing the unique challenges of film and television production.

This is a FOUR DAY class and will require your commitment to complete the course to receive your OSHA 30 Card. This course will not be offered regularly so opportunities to make up missed days will be rare.

This class is intended for people working as crew chiefs or department heads. This training is required by many employers who will be doing events around the upcoming events in Los Angeles such as the World Cup and Olympics.


